

What to bring:

(As little as possible)

1. ***REQUIRED: Two Motorola Talk About two-way radios (22 channel) and charger; 10-mile range is best. Radios must be charged in advance and ready to use upon arrival.***
2. ***REQUIRED: Rubber boots.***
3. Covered shoes, such as work boots or tennis shoes. Open shoes such as flip-flops, sandals, Crocs are not permitted for work.
4. Lightweight t-shirts or scrubs, they dry quickly (it is hot & wet in the summer), short and long sleeves.
5. Durable shorts & long pants with pockets
6. Rain poncho or rain jacket and rain pants and umbrella
7. Work gloves
8. Insect repellent
9. Sunglasses and hat.
10. If your internship is during the winter months, you will also need warm clothing, including hat, gloves and jacket. The temperatures drop into the 20's at night; and daytime temperatures are variable.
11. Flashlight and batteries.
12. Alarm clock (battery operated)
13. Personal items: soap, deodorant, shampoo, etc.
14. Twin sheets, pillow and towel.
15. Any special foods, drinks or medications such as aspirin, allergy pills, etc.
16. Laptop computer. Internet access is available, but you must provide your own computer. Office computers are NOT available for intern use.
17. A cellular phone. If you don't have a cell phone, you will need a phone card for any long-distance calls.
18. Binder with printed copy of Procedures Manual and notebook.
19. A strong back, your compassion, integrity, commitment to the monkeys in our care and a sense of humor is a must!
20. Swimming suit; you never know, you may get a chance to go to the river, lake or beach.
